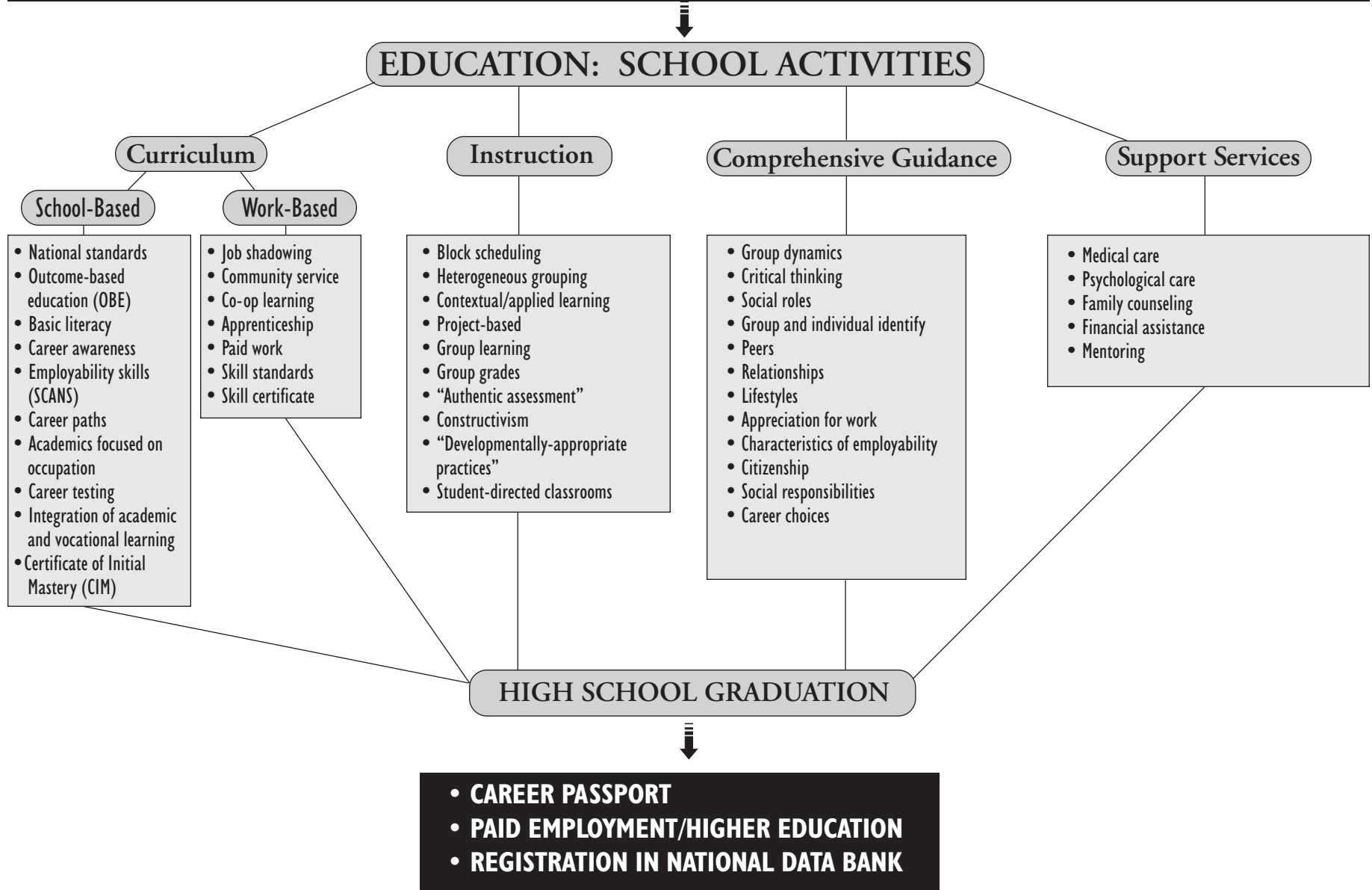

EDUCATION & WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT FEDERAL STATUTES 1994 - PRESENT

LOCAL SCHOOLS

- Educate for the workplace
- Train for an occupation
- Certify skills
- Recruit workers
- Job placement
- Retrain workers
- Provide community services to unemployed
- Collect workforce system data

STATE WORKFORCE BOARDS

- Establish state-wide partnerships with businesses
- Implement state economic and workforce plan
- Identify local workforce needs
- Develop and coordinate skill standards-based education and training according to state and national guidelines
- Work with schools to implement system
- Coordinate local data collection for state bank
- Secure funding for system

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

- Maintain public-private sector collaborative
- Establish national economic & workforce plan
- Oversee state implementation
- Establish national skill standards & certification
- Coordinate state systems of workforce education & training
- Oversee national databank of workforce certification and placement
- Develop funding sources for system
